Report 'Fuel report' - uplift & used fuel

The report is divided into **3** parts:

- **Flight information** - acft reg number, flight number, route, airports (if 'fuel report mode' is marked in the filter), client, legs number
- **Flight times & fuel details** - flight time, block time & average, fuel uplift, used fuel & average
- **Summary** - displayed below the above information

In the filter you can select data format (flight codes or route), an aircraft type or registration, client.
