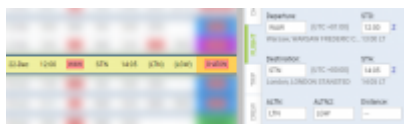


Default ALTN airports



Alternate airports displaying in Leon

Leon allows to define default **alternate airports** which will automatically show in a section Schedule (columns ALTN & ALTN2) and in a tab FLIGHT.

Click a tab **General** and type **Default ALTN1** airport's name or a code, then do the same for **Default ALTN2** (not mandatory).

Default ALTN1	<input type="text" value="EGGW/LTN"/>	
Default ALTN2	<input type="text" value="EGKK/LGW"/>	

Once ALTN airports are defined Leon will show them in a section Schedule, in brackets (you need to macr a checkbox 'ALTN' in the left-hand filter, tab 'SHOW' to get columns ALTN & ALTN2 displayed) and also in a tab FLIGHT (see the screenshot on the right).
