Indication of non-commercial Option on Trip

Leon will indicate whether the booked trip is commercial or non-commercial on a 'TRIP' selection button.

The indication will be marked by the relevant colour depending on the trip type and status, as per below:

- - **booked commercial trip, confirmed**
- - **booked non-commercial trip, confirmed**
- - **booked commercial trip, non-confirmed (Option)**
- - **booked non-commercial trip, non-confirmed (Option)**
- - **booked non-commercial trip, non-confirmed (Option) with due date indicated**
- - **deleted trip in the OPS section**

If the trip is **deleted in the edit quote section**, the 'TRIP' selection button disappears.
